

HEALTH AND SAFETY PLANS FOR DAY CARE CENTRES

All beneficiaries of the Community Chest undergo a thorough due diligence process where they are screened in order to meet our funding criteria. After doing our due diligence process it became apparent that most of the Day Care Centres have no training in the basic Health and Safety requirements.

Our objective is to implement Health and Safety programmes. We will touch on 8 simple facts that can have a vital impact on all our Day Care Centres. Each Centre will receive training in first Aid and fire safety. On completion of the training each one will receive a first aid kit and a fire extinguisher.

In accordance with the policy of SA Government regulation, Section 91 -103 of the children's act 38/2005 the training will cover the following:

- Adequate Supervision
- First Aid Training
- Administration of Medication
- Storage of Poisons and Toxic Substances
- Unsafe Nursery Products and Equipment
- Illness Transmission
- Food Safety
- Emergency Plan
